Ribes sanguineum

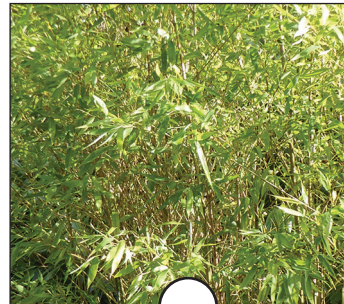


Found some!

Rhododendron luteum

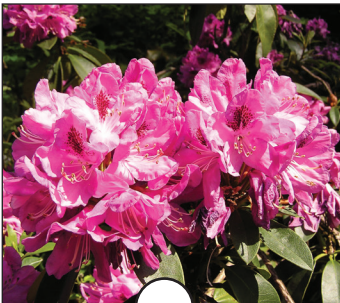

Rhododendron

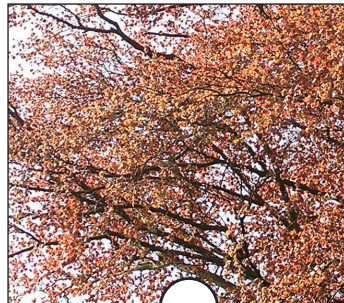

Pyrus salicifolia

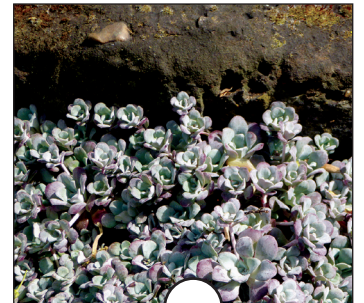


Found it!

Sedum spathulifolium

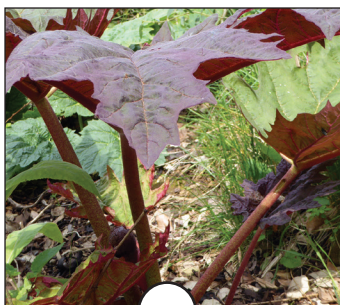

Dicksonia antarctica

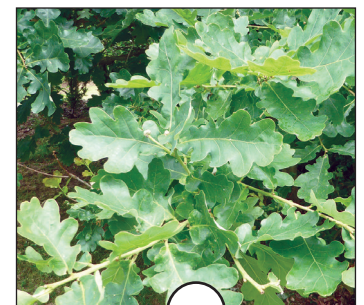
