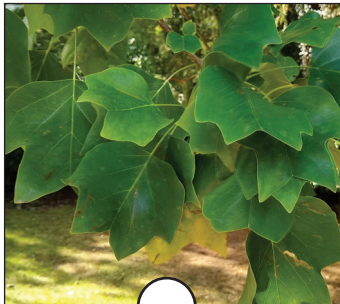
'I love Autumn plants & trees' trail

This fun trail contains just some of the plants and trees that are identifiable at this time of year.

Tulip Tree

Named because the leaves are shaped like tulips.

Scientific name:
Liriodendron tulipifera

Pyracantha

Popular shrub, with brightly coloured Autumn berries.

Scientific name:
Pyracantha sp.

Rowan tree

Has bright orange-red berries that feed wildlife all winter.

Scientific name:
Sorbus aucuparia

Japanese Laurel

Hardy evergreen, which gives year round colour.

Scientific name:
Aucuba japonica

Silver Birch

Common tree with distinctive silvery bark.

Scientific name:
Betula pendula

Beech

A great food source for lots of birds and mammals.

Scientific name:
Fagus sylvatica

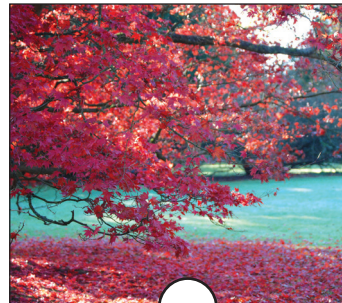

Scientific name:
Acer palmatum atropurpurea

Arbutus unedo

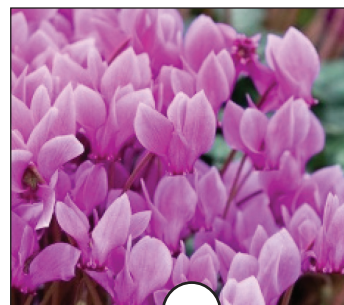

Cyclamen hederifolium

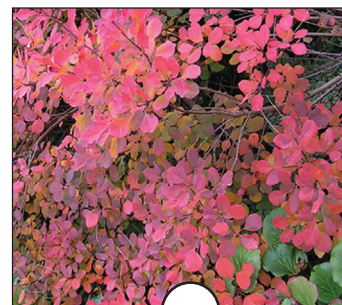
